PROFESSIONAL FELLOWS PROGRAM ECONOMIC EMPOWERMENT

The application period for the Professional Fellows Program (PFP) on Economic Empowerment for applicants from **El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras and Mexico** has opened. The PFP is sponsored by the United States Department of State and is administered by the Institute for Training and Development based in Massachusetts. While applications are open nationwide, preference will be given to residents of the states of **Guerrero, Veracruz, Oaxaca, Tabasco, Chiapas, Campeche, Yucatan, and Quintana Roo.**

This two-way exchange program is designed for young professionals to enhance their leadership and professional skills, build sustainable partnerships with U.S. hosts, and gain a deeper understanding of the conditions that promote innovation and sustainable economic development in the United States. For this prestigious program we seek candidates who are engaged in initiatives that address the root causes of irregular migration in their country. Professionals involved in entrepreneurship; small and medium enterprises; start-ups; business administration or business education; community training programs; non-governmental organizations; or government, are encouraged to apply.
